 - Ensuring all records relevant to the S.M.S and as defined in procedures are available
 - Passage planning plus updating charts and publication
 - Safety of passengers onboard and ensuring that all passengers onboard are in the passenger list/cargo manifest before the ship departure (MV Lady Samoa IV)
 - Safety of passengers onboard, ensuring the number of passengers and number of vehicles are correctly counted with tickets and the Administrations Officer clearance to be confirmed (MV Lady Samoa III / MV Samoa Express II)
 - Investigate damages to the vessel personal injuries and damages to the cargo
 - Monitoring any pollution and checking for oil spills around the vessel at Ports and Harbor
 - Allocating crew living quarters and work shifts for crew
 - Prepare trip planning
 - Operate vessel to safe of navigation using Publication and Electronic equipments
 - Monitor crew STCW's / Medical Cert
 - Able to deal and organize any problems effectively in open sea
 - Filled in Log Book activities and sign
